United Nations International School Hanoi: December 2011

J&C Joel have manufactured a comprehensive range of dress and stage masking curtains for the stage of the United Nations (UN) International School in Hanoi, Vietnam.

Established in 1988 with the support of the United Nations Development Programme in Vietnam, the UN school educates over 1,000 pupils from pre-school to secondary school age through a comprehensive curriculum that reflects the broad international community of the United Nations.

J&C Joel manufactured a main curtain to dress the stage of the school's theatre manufactured from a specially dyed cognac Heavy Velvet Velour (VEL023). Measuring 8.35 metres wide and with a drop of 6.9 metres, these curtains were supplied along with backing curtains made to the same dimensions in J&C Joel's Premier Blackout (PB001) fabric.

These backing curtains are secured to the main stage curtains using spot Velcro, which is attached to the edges of the curtains. A cognac Heavy Velvet Velour valance was also manufactured to dress the front of the school's stage.

J&C Joel also manufactured a Cotton Cyclorama Canvas in white (CAN022) measuring 13.5 metres wide by 7.8 metres and a Front Projection Screen in white (PVC044) measuring 8 metres by 4.5 metres. J&C Joel also supplied a full complement of stage masking curtains, including mid and rear stage masking tabs, masking borders, and legs; all manufactured by J&C Joel from black Premier Wool Serge (WS090).
